BY-LAW NO. 65-2010

**Being a by-law to prescribe fee and charges for the
Provision of Fire Services**

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipality of Whitestone has adopted by resolution the Standard Operating Guidelines (SOGs) for the Whitestone Fire Rescue Department to ensure a consistent response by all Fire Department members to emergency situations;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Act 2001, S.O. 2001, Chapter 25, Part XII, Section 391(1), a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons, for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it and for the use of its property including property under its control;

AND WHEREAS, the Municipal Act, 2001, Ontario Regulations 244/02 provides for imposing fees and charges for inspection of the issuance of permits for fire services;

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, S. O. 2001, Chapter 25, Part XII and Ontario Regulations 244/02, notice of intent to pass this by-law has been given.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of Whitestone hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Service Fee for the Provision of Fire Services shall be as set out in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this by-law;
2. The fees listed under "Fire Services" in By-Law 21-2008 shall be rescinded;
3. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage thereof.
