Greetings from Larry Samis, WCA Chair

Welcome to our 24th edition of Welcome to Whitestone.

Our lakes continue to show high quality test results, but these results are provided by chemical tests; acidity, oxygen content, nitrates and phosphates. The true test will be whether aquatic life is flourishing in these conditions. As a result, we, along with the Municipality, and biologists from the Georgian Bay Biosphere will be implementing a 3 year programme, called benthic monitoring. It will involve the collection of various species of macroorganisms, checking their health and populations. This will allow us to tell if there are other factors that may affect the well being of the aquatic life in our lakes.

The Municipality has made changes to the use of the waste disposal sites, moving the dumping of brush to the Auld's site and construction materials, boats to McFarlane Street in Parry Sound. This will create more room at the Dunchurch site. However we all still need to be vigilant about recycling.

Thanks to all our volunteers for their hard work. We are still looking for new members with fresh ideas and new energy. This year our meetings are at the Royal Canadian Legion, on Hwy 124. Visit our website for meeting times and more information.

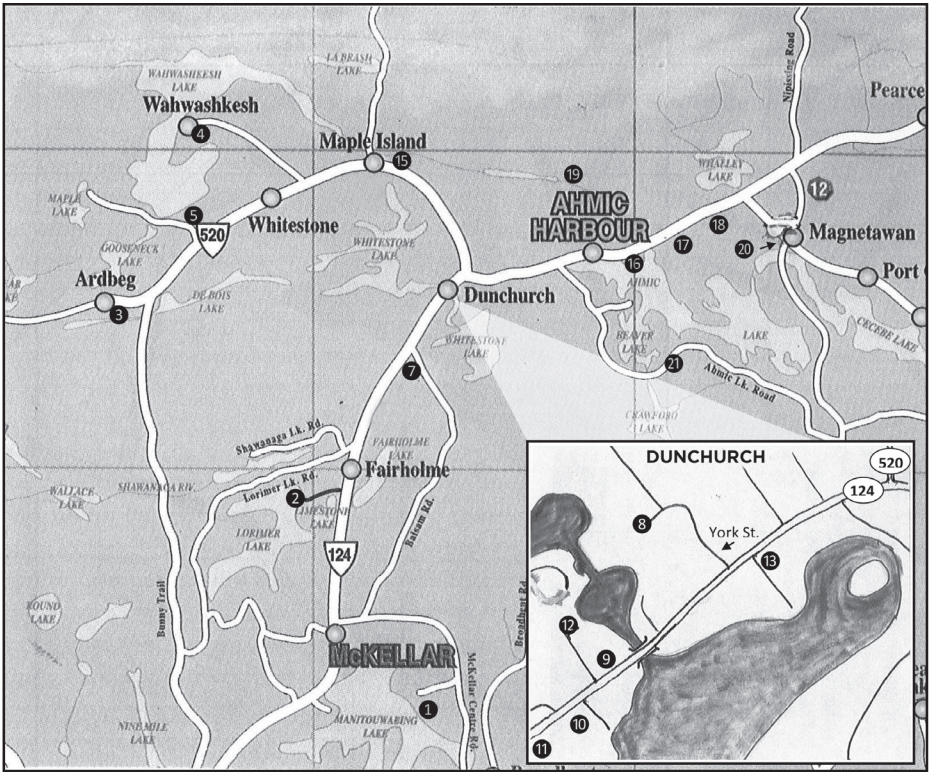
